Step 1: Admissions & Pre-Advising

- o Complete the LSC application (lonestar.edu/admissions).
- o Visit with your HS Dual Credit Counselor to determine course(s) selection, pre-requisites and eligibility.
- Note: Bacterial Meningitis Vaccination is not required for Dual Credit unless you intend to take a course held on a LSC campus (Ionestar.edu/meningitis). New Student Orientation & Student Success Course holds do not apply while students are enrolled in dual credit.

Step 2: Testing/Placement

- Visit with your HS Dual Credit Counselor to request your testing referral (unless indicated). You must complete testing by your High School campus' predetermined deadline date to be able to register for dual credit courses.
- Complete the pre-assessment activity via myLoneStar if testing is required.
- o The initial placement test is free of charge. Re-tests will have a fee associated.
- Complete your placement testing at one of the 3 Assessment Centers: CyFair Campus in the CASA Student Services building, Fairbanks Center in room 115, or Cypress Center in room 114. Check with your Dual Credit counselor for optional testing sites. A photo ID is required at ALL testing sites.

Step 3: Registering & Dropping classes

- Registration: Bring your Dual credit course approval form to your Dual Credit Counselor completed, including signatures from parent/legal guardian and student prior to your High School campus' predetermined deadline date.
 Students must complete each college course attempted with a grade of "C" or better in order to continue in the program.
 - The HS Dual Credit counselor will review the course approval form and if approved, they will sign and send the form directly to LSC-CyFair for processing.
 - LSC-CyFair will process your registration, if you meet the LSC requirements for enrollment and/or courses.
- Dropping: You must have approval from your HS Dual Credit Counselor. All drop forms must be submitted through
 your HS Dual Credit Counselor, who will send the form directly to LSC-CyFair for processing.
 - Drops after the LSC official day of record will receive a "W" (withdraw) on your college transcript.
 - Full refunds will only be issued to drops made prior to the first day of class. All drops made during the first 15 calendar days of the semester will be 70% refund. Drops made the 16-20th calendar days will be at 25% refund.

 No refunds after the 20th calendar day.

Step 4: Pay your tuition

- o Go online to: lonestar.edu and click on MyLoneStar and login using your User ID and password.
- o View your Fee/Schedule to ensure that you have been registered for the desired courses.
- Select the online payment options in your MyLoneStar account or visit the payment/business counter at LSC-CyFair, LSC-Cypress Center, or LSC-Fairbanks Center. Payment plans are available to dual credit students, but you must enroll online and pay a \$20 administrative fee. * *Refer to payment calendar for deadlines.**

Step 5: Purchase your books

o Visit the LSC Campus Book Store to purchase/rent all required textbooks. Take your class schedule for assistance.

Important Dates

- Fall Registration - All course approval forms must be submitted by: May 1, 2019
 - > Registration deadline may differ from LSC System deadline and depending on high school campus.
- Preferred payment due date: August 1, 2019
 - > On average, a student will pay \$72 for fees (3 CR class) as tuition is waived. Prices are subject to change.



Course Placement Scores: Dual Credit

A high school student in grades 9-12 is eligible to enroll in dual credit courses if the student meets the prerequisites requirements relevant to the courses attempted for both high school and college credit. For specific enrollment requirements and prerequisites for high school credit, please meet with your high school counselor. All Dual Credit courses require approval from the high school counselor to ensure high school graduation requirements are met. For specific enrollment requirements and prerequisites for college credit, please refer to the Lone Star College System catalog for Description of Courses to determine required TSI subject area compliance. Eligibility for enrollment in a dual credit course requires the high school student to meet all of the College's regular prerequisite requirements for that course, such as a minimum score on a specified placement test and/or minimum grade in a specified previous course.

A high school student is eligible to enroll in dual credit courses if the student demonstrates that he or she is exempt under the provisions of the Texas Success Initiative.




