The Charger Canine Clinic is open and now accepting dogs. Below are the guidelines if you are interested in having your dog here at school.

1. Appointments can only be made AFTER the registration form and a copy of the latest vaccination records have been received. **DO NOT** bring animals to school until you have a confirmed appointment. **We will call & confirm the day before your appointment. Please bring your own dog food in a ziplock bag. We have bowls.**
2. Dogs must be current on Distemper/Parvo and Rabies Vaccines. Flu and Kennel Cough Vaccines are highly recommended. Dogs with aggressive tendencies, super hyperactive personalities and non potty and kennel trained will not be accepted.
3. Dogs must be brought in and taken out through the exterior doors at the end of the hallway located by 1652 or 1657 near the ag rooms. (Where the aluminum livestock trailer is parked.)
4. Once you drop your dog off, you may not take your dog out of the classroom until you leave for the day. Dogs will not be visiting classrooms or roaming hallways.
5. Payment must be made upon drop off or pick up of animal. We take cash or check. Please make checks payable to **FHS #60.**

Full Services Offered:

Day Care—only includes handling, play time and walks

Bath -includes a wash with oatmeal shampoo, dry, brush and Canine Cologne

Nail Trim-will trim to the quick-we do not trim deeply

Full Body Brushing-Furminator brushing with removal of any matted fur

Ear Cleaning-Epi-Otic solution will be used to remove debris from ear

Teeth Brushing-we use meat flavored paste to remove grime off the surface of teeth

Fecal Sample-Sample taken and checked for worms

Groom/Clip-Summer Shaves and trims are easier for us (We are beginners at grooming.)
