
Keep our building safe. Never let

If you are a band student that needs to pick up an instrument you will be released with walker and wait to be released with motor transportation.




CELL PHONES

SAFETY CONFLICT


If you are having an issue with another student, <u>let</u>








BUS EXPECTATIONS

- TEMPORARY IDS WILL CONTINUE TO BE PROVIDED TO STUDENTS WITHOUT IDS.


(UPON ENTERING THE BUILDING)

- -When a student reaches 3 tardies, their parents will get an email and phone call notifying them of their student's actions. Those students will sign a behavior contract.
- -When a student reaches **7 tardies**, Skyward will generate an office referral. APs will assign a consequence as appropriate.
- -When a student reaches 10 tardies, Skyward will generate an office referral. APs will assign a consequence as appropriate.
