



above, a lease agreement or closing
statement will work as proof of residency.

Why enroll your child in Pre K?

90% of human brain development happens before age 5. By registering your child in LCISD's Pre-K program, you give them the gift of a brighter future.

Studies show that kids who attend Pre-K are:

- 3 x more likely to be ready for Kindergarten
- More likely to succeed in school
- More likely to go to college
- Less likely to drop out of school

Enrollment

Child must be 4 years of age on or before September 1, 2017.

Documentation Needed:

- Child's birth certificate
- Child's shot records
- Child's Social Security Card
- Parent/guardian picture ID
- Proof of address
- Parent proof of income

Qualifications

Child must meet at least one of the following:

- Be economically disadvantaged
- Be Limited English Proficient
- Be homeless
- Be under Foster Care (currently or formerly)
- Be the child of an active duty member of the armed forces or be the child of a active duty member who was injured/killed while on active duty
