

Dear Lindsey Families,

Last week we awarded our first Lindsey volunteer of the year during our Den Celebration. Congratulations to Watch DOG Gaylon! Gaylon is one of our many grandfathers that volunteer multiple times weekly to assist in making Lindsey Elementary the best it can be! It was an honor and a privilege to crown him our volunteer of the year.

I know school safety is on all our minds, and the events in Florida are weighing heavily on our hearts. The tragedy that unfolded last week is truly my worst nightmare as a parent and as a school leader. It is my priority to ensure that your children come to school each day in a safe environment. At Lindsey Elementary we have an extensive safety plan and conduct drills on a regular basis to ensure our students and our staff know exactly what to do. Some of our drills occur monthly and others occur several times over the course of the year. There are times when we get complaints about safety procedures that we have in place because they are an inconvenience to some. Please know this is never our intention. When we ask that you not drop off your students in a parking lot it is not to make you late for work, but instead to ensure your child does not cross our constantly moving car rider line. When our front office asks you to please go back to your car and get your ID so you can be checked in through our system, it is always for the safety of our students and staff. When you are in our building not wearing your raptor badge and a teacher stops to ask if you need assistance, please know this is because you are a stranger that appears to be roaming the halls. When you do not have the correct card to pick up your child as a walker or a bus rider, please go get it to ensure we are connecting kids with their rightful guardian as we may not recognize you! If you want to know how you can help, please follow the safety rules with fidelity and refrain from giving the staff a hard time when they are working so hard to ensure our kids' safety. Concerns can come directly to me, as I would be glad to hear your solutions. I am always looking to refine our current practices and make them better. Feedback is a gift. I honestly appreciate those of you who have called and offered suggestions. You have helped make Lindsey a better school

I wanted to update you on a safety concern about the door leading from the front office to the main hallway. I have requested that a buzzer be installed, so the door will stay locked at all times to visitors unless access is granted by our front office personnel. Until the buzzer is installed we will be replacing the lock to keep the door locked during school hours. This may cause parents to wait a little longer to enter the building once checked in, but we believe this is a necessary safety precaution until our buzzer is installed. As educators, we are in this profession to serve and teach children. We want them to learn, grow, to become the very best person they can be. Above all else, we want them to return to you every night safe and sound.

To our dads, grandfathers, and father figures, we are putting out a big SOS to you! One of the main objectives of our Watch DOG program is safety! When we are blessed enough to have Watch DOGs on campus, part of their assignment throughout the day is to walk the perimeter of our building to ensure all doors and gates are locked and our building is secured. We ask that they help keep an eye out for any suspicious behavior and report it immediately. In addition to being a great role model for our kids and assisting the teachers, our Watch DOGs give us a male presence in our building. February 27: 3rd and 4th Grade (Math)
5th Grade (Science)


February 28: 3rd and 4th Grade (Reading)

This information will be utilized for diagnostics purposes only, therefore a grade will not be taken. This test will be conducted in the same manner as the STAAR test.

It is important that your child be in attendance and on time that day. Please arrange any doctor's appointments for after school and make sure your child brings a sack lunch or lunch money with them to school. We ask that parents not bring in fast food items or lunches on this day for any grade level due to schedule changes and test security.

Parents and visitors are not allowed on campus on the dates listed above. Therefore, visitors are not allowed to eat lunch with students at any grade level, volunteer, or visit the classrooms.

We appreciate your assistance in helping us create a positive testing environment for all students.







- Scroll down to the 'Community Rewards' section of your account page.

Any transactions moving forward using the card number associated with your digital account will be applied to the program.

It takes approximately 10 days for the Community Rewards total to begin displaying on your receipt.
