Parking Policy/Rules

- All student vehicles must be registered with Foster HS. A new parking permit must be purchased each school year.
- Parking permits will be sold for \$50.00. Eligible students must have a valid driver's license and provide proof of insurance with the registered vehicle listed on the insurance card.
- As deemed appropriate by administration, parking privileges may be revoked for the following reasons but not limited to: persistent misbehavior, a major disciplinary infraction, violation of school's policy, speeding (speed limit on campus is 15mph), unsafe or reckless driving, ALC 20 days or more, incurring excessive absences, tardies or offenses as determined by administration, failing to pay an outstanding fine (textbooks, library, lunch, etc.)
- Violations may result in the loss of parking privileges. If these privileges are suspended for any length of time, the parking permit will be removed from the student. A new parking permit must be purchase for \$50.00 if the parking privileges are reinstated by administration.
- The issuance of a parking permit is considered a privilege. This privilege may be revoked at the discretion of school administration.
- Motor vehicles parked on school grounds must visibly display the annual permit from the rear-view mirror. Vehicles without a visibly displayed permit will have a warning sticker placed on their window, wheel locked, or towed at the owner's expense.
- Vehicles should be locked at all times. The school is not responsible for vehicles or their contents while they are parked on school property.
- Any vehicle parked illegally in fire lanes, handicapped spaces, or in another person's reserved space designated by its permit, will have a warning sticker put in their window, wheel locked, and/or towed at the owner's expense. LCISD Police may issue fire lane and/or handicap parking tickets.
- The privilege of bringing a student-operated motor vehicle onto school premises is hereby conditioned by the owner of the motor vehicle and the parent/guardian of the student to allow a search of that motor vehicle when there is reasonable suspicion for the search. Student vehicles are subject to search if there is reason to believe drugs, alcohol, stolen property, or other items might be present in that vehicle. Anything found in a student's vehicle is considered to be in his/her possession. Refusal to provide access to a motor vehicle shall be cause for termination, without further hearing or refund, of the privilege of bringing a motor vehicle onto school premises.
- Motor vehicles driven on school grounds must be operated in conformance with regulations of the State of Texas, the City of Richmond, Rosenberg, Lamar CISD, and the Texas Board of Education
- Students are not allowed to loiter in their vehicles or in the school's parking lot before, during, or after school.
- Permits sold to a student are for use by that student ONLY. All students involved in the purchase and subsequent resale of a permit, or using a permit that does not belong to them, will be disciplined. Forgery of permits may result in a police citation, loss of parking privileges, and/or suspension.
- Students who withdraw from FHS for any reason (moving, ALC, 16-21, etc) will no longer be allowed to park on campus. The parking permit will become invalid, it must be returned to FHS, the parking space will be sold, and no refund will be issued. In the event the student returns to FHS, he/she may follow the normal procedure to obtain a new parking permit.
- Students who enter/leave campus outside of normal school hours must use the main entrance.
- A wheel lock may be used for parking violations. Students must pay a \$25 fine to have a wheel lock removed from their vehicle. Students will not be permitted to drive to school until the fine has been paid.
- Replacement tags will cost \$20.00 and can be purchased at the Attendance Office.
