Therefore, I understand that the commitment of certain offenses could result in my immediate dismissal from NHS. These offenses include, but are not limited to, cheating, vandalism, slander, theft, assault, and the use of alcohol or drugs at school events.

Specifically in regards to cheating, I understand that the teacher is the sole judge of what constitutes cheating. I recognize that cheating can include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Copying another student's answers on a quiz, test, or individual assignment
- Sharing homework, class work, or any written assignment
- Sharing quiz/test information with other students
- Plagiarizing from published sources or other students
- Using previous or current student's notebooks as a study guide
- Collaborating on assignments that are assigned as independent work
- Using another's project as your own.

A member accused of any behavior related to the above mentioned offenses must report the incident to the advisor immediately. Based on the information received, the student will go before the Faculty Advisory Council for disciplinary action, which may include immediate dismissal from NHS, even if the student has received no other demerits or warnings regarding his/her membership. A student accused of such behavior who fails to report the incident to the advisor will be dismissed from the NHS.
