## Excerpt from 2022-2023 Secondary Student Handbook

DRESS AND GROOMING

| ITEM | ACCEPTABLE DRESS | SPECIAL COMMENTS AND INTERPRETATIONS |
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| Shirts, Blouses | Shirts/blouses may be: <br> - Any collared shirt/blouse <br> - T-shirts and other pull-over tops <br> - Sweatshirts <br> - School designs/logos, brand names and/or other appropriate words are acceptable <br> Shirts and blouses must be buttoned in accordance with design and appropriateness. | Students are prohibited from wearing shirts/blouses that: <br> - Are oversized or immodestly undersized. <br> - Are made of see-through/sheer material unless worn over acceptable shirt/or blouse. <br> - Depict or reference alcohol, drugs, tobacco, weapons, nudity, gang affiliation, death, violence, vulgar or obscene language or images, and/or insults to race, religion, gender, or ethnicity, or other emblems or writing that may be expected to cause a material or substantial disruption of, or interference with, normal school operations. <br> Undershirts, tank tops, spaghetti straps, blouses or clothing that exposes cleavage or the midriff when the arms are raised may not be worn. |
| Pants, Slacks | Acceptable pants/slacks are worn at the waist, belted, if appropriate, and not "baggy". | Pants/slacks may not be: <br> - Made of inappropriate form-fitting materials. <br> - Made of see-through/sheer material. <br> - Baggy, sagging, or oversized. <br> - No pajamas <br> No holes or tears above mid-thigh that expose skin are acceptable unless worn over leggings or tights. <br> Leggings worn as pants must be accompanied by a shirt/dress/skirt covering to mid-thigh length. |
| Shorts | Acceptable shorts are no shorter than mid-thigh for all grades. | Shorts may not be: <br> - Made of inappropriate form-fitting materials. <br> - Baggy, sagging, or oversized. <br> - Boxers or pajamas. <br> - Made of see-through/sheer material. <br> No holes or tears above mid-thigh are acceptable unless worn over leggings or tights. |
| Dresses, Skorts, Skirts | Dresses/skorts/skirts are: <br> - Worn at the waist (skirts/skorts). <br> - No shorter than mid-thigh for all grades. <br> Dress tops must meet the guidelines required for blouses and shirts. | Dresses/skorts/skirts may not be of revealing or formfitting materials. <br> Slits in skirts or dresses must not be higher than midthigh. <br> Dresses/skorts/skirts must be no shorter than midthigh regardless of whether leggings are worn. |
| Shoes | Shoes must be: <br> - Worn at all times. <br> - Chosen for safety and health reasons and for quietness. <br> Athletic shoes with a rubber sole, closed toes, and full support around the heel should be worn for PE. | Shoes over 1 inch high, "slides", and flip-flops are not recommended for safety reasons. <br> House shoes and shoes with wheels are not acceptable. |
| Hair | Hair must be clean, well-groomed and out of the eyes, and shall be a nondistracting hair color that is styled in a way that is neither distracting nor conspicuous. | Facial hair must be clean and well-groomed and styled in a way that is neither distracting nor conspicuous. Hair styles that create a safety hazard or a material/substantial disruption are not permitted. |


| Accessories | Earrings, hair jewelry, watches, bracelets, rings, and necklaces that are not a safety hazard or a material or substantial disruption may be worn. | Jewelry that is considered gang-related is not allowed. Jewelry (including earrings, ear stretchers, grills, body piercing, chains, emblems, etc.) which is considered to be a safety hazard or a material/substantial disruption is not permitted. |
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| General | School-approved uniforms for physical education, athletics, pep rallies, etc., may be worn only during the class or activity for which they are approved. <br> For unique special events the campus administration may establish event-specific dress code requirements. | Hats, caps, sport headbands, bandanas, headcovers, or scarves shall not be worn indoors except in the interest of religious practices, safety, cleanliness, or with the permission of the principal. <br> No article or apparel shall be worn that will in any way damage school property, create a safety hazard, or create a material or substantial disruption to the school environment. <br> Tattoos, accessories, jewelry, and clothing that contain vulgar or inappropriate pictures, vulgar or inappropriate words or drawings, or gang-related markings are not permitted. |
| Additional regulations for grades 6-8 | Facial hair must be clean shaven during class time through eighth grade. <br> Hair must be a natural color that is neither distracting nor conspicuous. | Students shall not have hair that is psychedelic colors nor have letters or designs shaved in their head. <br> Students may not wear nose rings, visible body or facial piercings. |

The district's dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, prevent disruption, and minimize safety hazards. Any article of clothing or grooming the principal or designee determines inappropriate, a safety concern, or can reasonably be expected to cause disruption or interference with normal school operations is prohibited.
