

Progress Monitoring Assessments

- 7th grade Science and Social Studies students will take LCISD Progress Monitoring Assessments mid April.
 - Face to face students will test during the class period
 - Virtual students will test at home through Eduphoria Aware Online found in Classlink
 - Dates TBA by your student's teachers (check <u>Canvas</u> calendars for each course)
 - These are best when completed in one sitting.
- These will gauge student progress on standards covered by that point in the year.
- Must be done on a laptop, desktop computer, or iPad (no phones).
 - Students will access the Eduphoria Aware App through Classlink.
 - Log in is the same as Classlink without student initials
 - Ex. Classlink log in: ao123456 Eduphoria log in: 123456
 - The password is the same used for Classlink

IMPORTANT STAAR INFORMATION **FOLLOWS**

7th STAAR Writing

- The 7th STAAR Writing Test will be Tuesday, April 6th.
- Room assignments for Face to Face students will posted in the gym, cafeteria, and outside the library on Monday, April 5th – be sure to check it to see where your are testing on Tuesday.

VIRTUAL STUDENT INFORMATION

- If you have opted in to test, you should have received an email from Blair O'Connor. Please review the information in that email.
- If you still want your child to test, please complete the <u>7th STAAR</u>
 <u>Writing Survey</u> to be scheduled on a make up day (04/13/2021).
- You must indicate yes or no on the survey if you are a virtual student. Parents who did not respond should have, or will receive, a phone call from the school to determine if your student is coming to campus to test.
- If you have already filled out the survey for this test, you do not need to do so again.



LCISD's Virtual Student Participation in the Texas Assessment Program Information for Parents

The Texas Education Agency requires these assessments to be administered in-person by certified and trained personnel. Therefore, these assessments cannot be administered remotely. The Texas Assessment Program includes the following assessments:

- ★ STAAR Grades 3-8 & End Of Course
- ★ STAAR ALTERNATE 2 for Grades 3-8
 - ★ TELPAS for Grades K-12
- ★ TELPAS ALTERNATE for Grades K-12

LCISD highly recommends that virtual students participate in state testing as appropriate to the child's grade level and needs as outlined below. Tests will be given in the timeframes provided on the district testing calendars located at: https://www.lcisd.org/students-parents/testing-information.

Elementary and Secondary Virtual Students:

★ STAAR

Virtual students in Grades 3-8 will be offered the opportunity to come to their home campus to take their STAAR tests. Campus personnel will reach out to parents about scheduling testing opportunities.

STAAR Alternate 2 (Grades 3-8 & EOC)

STAAR Alternate 2 is administered to special education students with significant cognitive disabilities in a one-on-one setting with the student and the teacher – at the child's home campus. Campus personnel will reach out to the parents of eligible virtual students about scheduling testing opportunities.

★ TELPAS & TELPAS Alternate (English Language Learners in Grades 2-12)

Eligible Bilingual and English as a Second Language virtual students will be offered the opportunity to come to campus to take their TELPAS tests. Campus personnel will reach out to the parents of eligible virtual students about scheduling testing opportunities.

Secondary Virtual Students Only:

★ STAAR End of Course

Virtual students currently taking English 1, English 2, Algebra 1, Biology, and/or US History will be offered the opportunity to come to their home campus to take their EOC assessments. Since EOCs are a graduation requirement, LCISD strongly recommends participation. Campus personnel will reach out to students and parents about scheduling testing opportunities.

All Elementary and Secondary Virtual Students:

* Transportation

Alternate transportation will not be offered for virtual students to come to campus for testing. The parent/guardian or student will need to provide their own transportation for testing.

★ Make-Ups

If a student is quarantined on their assigned testing date, the campus will work directly with the student and parent to schedule a make-up -- if possible.



Participación del estudiante de LCISD que recibe instrucción virtual en los "Programas de Evaluaciones de Texas" Información para padres

La Agencia de Educación de Texas solicita que los exámenes del estado se realicen en forma presencial con personal capacitado y certificado; por tanto, los exámenes no serán de forma virtual. El programa de evaluación de Texas incluye los siguientes exámenes:

- ★ STAAR del 3^{er} al 8º grado y de final del curso
 - ★ STAAR ALTERNATE II del 3º al 8º grado
 - ⋆ TELPAS del Kínder al 12º grado
- ★ TELPAS ALTERNATE del Kínder al 12º grado

Lamar CISD recomienda firmemente que los estudiantes que reciben instrucción virtual se presenten a los exámenes de nivel y necesidades adecuados que marca el estado de acuerdo a lo siguiente: https://www.lcisd.org/students-parents/testing-information.

Estudiantes de primaria/secundaria / preparatoria que reciben instrucción virtual:

* STAAR

Los estudiantes que reciben instrucción virtual del 3º al 8º grado tendrán la oportunidad de tomar los exámenes de STARR en su escuela. El personal de la escuela se comunicará con los padres para programar dichos exámenes.

★ STAAR Alternate II (del 3º al 8º grado & EOC)

El STAAR Alternate II se administrará individualmente (maestro-estudiante), en la escuela, a estudiantes de educación especial con discapacidades cognitivas significativas. El personal se comunicará con los padres de estudiantes que reciben instrucción virtual y son elegibles para programar los exámenes.

TELPAS & TELPAS Alternate (Estudiantes que se encuentran aprendiendo el inglés del 2° al 12^{vo}grado)

A los estudiantes bilingües y aquellos que se encuentran aprendiendo el inglés como segundo idioma de forma virtual y son elegibles, se les ofrecerá la oportunidad de presentarse a la escuela para tomar los exámenes TELPAS. El personal de la escuela se pondrá en contacto con los padres de estudiantes elegibles para programar los exámenes.

<u>Únicamente para estudiantes de</u> <u>secundaria/preparatoria que reciben</u> <u>instrucción virtual:</u>

★ STAAR de FIN DE CURSO

Los estudiantes que reciben instrucción virtual en Inglés I, Inglés II, Algebra I, Biología y/o Historia de EE.UU. deben tomar los exámenes de EOC en la escuela; Lamar CISD recomienda enfáticamente su participación ya que los exámenes son requisito para poder graduarse. El personal de la escuela se comunicará con los padres y estudiantes para programar los exámenes.

Todos los estudiantes de primaria, secundaria y preparatoria que reciben instrucción virtual:

* Transporte

No se dispone de servicio de transporte para los estudiantes de instrucción virtual que se presenten a tomar los exámenes.

Examen (reprogramación)

Si el estudiante se encuentra en cuarentena el día del examen, la escuela trabajará directamente con el padre y el estudiante para reprogramar el examen (si es posible).

STAAR TESTING INFORMATION

- STAAR testing will occur in April (7th writing) and May (EOC, all other tests)
 - Schedule follows
- All STAAR testing will be done <u>ONLINE</u>
 - Benefits of online testing:
 - More flexibility in scheduling
 - Results will come in faster



Per TEA, students must take the STAAR test for their grade level. Therefore, if you are an 8th grader taking geometry, you will take the 8th grade math STAAR this year.

MAKE UP STAAR TESTING INFORMATION

- Testing will occur everyday within the window allowed per TEA.
 - For 7th writing that is every Tuesday from 04/06-05/04/2021
 - For the Algebra I EOC that will be everyday from 05/04-05/26/2021.
 - For 7th Math/Reading, 8th Math/Reading/Science/Social Studies that will be everyday from 05/06-05/26.
- If you are absent on the day of the test, but return to school within the window, you will still take the STAAR test that you missed.
