Online assessments can be done through Canvas or Eduphoria Aware Online Testing (as designated by the teacher).

Both sites are accessed through LCISD's Classlink page.

Eduphoria Aware Online Eduphoria Online is newer platform for our students.


It includes many features to aid students as they test, as well as allows better data tracking for out teachers to gauge student progress.

DLJH Online Testing Information Testing Procedures & Integrity

All tests are timed to keep testing equitable for both our face-to-face and virtual learners.

Extra time is given as an accommodation when needed.



Virtual students need to log in to take online assessments during the class period they are assigned.

If this does not fit with a virtual student's schedule, they must make contact with their teacher to schedule a test time between 8:00-4:15 on the day of the test. Teachers may adjust the time frame if needed.

Students signed up for <u>face-to-face</u> learning for the 2nd six weeks will test at Leaman Junior High on October 14, 2020.





School Board calls for \$792.5 million bond election

Lamar CISD is the 5th fastest growing school district in Texas. Over the last decade, the District has added over 11,000 students – with another 20,000 to 29,000 projected to arrive over the next 10 years. Lamar CISD currently uses 206 portable classrooms around the District to address the increasing number of students.

What's in the Bond 2020 proposal?

Due to recent legislation, the 2020 Bond will be separated into four propositions on the November ballot.



Proposition A*:

New School Facilities, Renovations, School Buses, Safety and Security, Land -\$645,228,864



Proposition B*:

Practice Pools - \$31,937,031



Proposition C*:

District Stadium and Land - \$93,783,238



Proposition D*:

District Technology Equipment - \$21,582,000


The majority of Bond 2020 is for new facilities and land, renovations and safety and security. This includes High School #7, Junior High School #7, three new elementary schools, and interior and exterior improvements to many campuses. 40,000 houses on the horizon

Lamar CISD is projected to add over 40,000 new single-family homes and over 8,000 multi-family homes over the next decade – with an additional 1,000+ students projected each year. Out of the 61 Greater Houston school districts, Lamar CISD ranked second for most housing starts in 2019.

Citizens' Bond Committee

A 61-member Citizens' Bond Advisory Committee, composed of community members from across the District, met in April and May to study growth and demographic trends, and to review current and future needs. In June, the committee recommended the Board call a bond election.

Bond 2020 impact to homeowner

Bonds will be sold over a period of years to reduce the impact on the tax rate. Since 2003, Lamar CISD has passed five bond elections totaling more than \$1.3 billion and has maintained a steady total tax rate for the past decade, with a decline in the total tax rate in each of the last two years. Lamar CISD strategically manages the timing of bond sales and monitors property value growth to control the tax rate.

If all propositions pass, Lamar CISD residents with a taxable value of \$75,000 could see an estimated debt service tax increase of approximately \$5 a month or \$60 a year after all bonds have been issued. The amount would increase above \$60 a year with increased property valuation. However, senior citizens whose property taxes are frozen would not be impacted.

If property value growth exceeds 6.5%, the tax impact could be significantly less.



Impacto que puede tener el Bono 2020 en la vivienda

Los bonos se venderán durante varios años para reducir el impacto fiscal que pueda existir. Lamar CISD ha aprobado, cinco bonos de elección desde el 2003 con un total de más de 1.300 millones de dólares, y ha mantenido una tasa de impuesto de deuda estable durante nueve años (esto incluyendo el año 2020). El distrito de Lamar CISD maneja estratégicamente los lapsos de venta de bonos, y monitorea el incremento del valor de la propiedad para controlar la tasa de impuestos.

Si todas las propuestas pasan, los residentes de Lamar CISD que tienen un valor de impuesto del \$75,000 podrían ver un aumento de aproximádamente \$5 al mes o de \$60 al año, una vez que todos los bonos se hayan emitido. El monto arriba de \$60 al año, incrementaría el valor de la propiedad. Sin embargo, las personas mayores de la tercera edad que tengan congelados sus impuestos de la propiedad no serán afectados.

Si el crecimiento del valor de la propiedad supera el 6.5%, el impacto fiscal podría ser significatiramente menor.



Fall 2020 Guidance - Secondary

Student & Staff Safety Protocols for Screening & Isolation (page 1)

General

All students and staff will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms regularly and individuals who show symptoms will be separated and sent home.

Screening Protocols **UPDATED Sept. 17, 2020**

- Staff will be required to self-screen for COVID-19 symptoms prior to reporting to work each day.
- Parents/guardians are expected to screen their students for COVID-19 symptoms each day prior to sending their student to school:
 - Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
 - Loss of taste or smell
 - o Cough
 - Difficulty breathing
 - Shortness of breath
 - o Fatigue
 - Headache
 - o Chills
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Shaking
 - o Exaggerated shivering
 - o Significant muscle pain or ache
 - Diarrhea
 - o Nausea or vomiting

*If your student is exhibiting one or more of these symptoms, you will be asked to contact your student's medical provider for further guidance and not return to school. Nurses will continuously monitor the screening process and follow up with the parent/guardian on the health status of the students.

- Teachers will monitor students and refer to the nurse if symptoms are present.
- For further information and/or guidance, please refer to the section "Individuals Suspected with COVID-19."

Isolation Protocols

Student or Staff Displaying COVID-19 Symptoms

- When a student has displayed one or more symptoms of COVID-19, the school nurse will provide a clinical assessment to determine if and when a student needs to be sent home.
- Students who are ill will be separated from their peers and should be picked up within 30 minutes and no later than one hour from the time the campus contacted the student's parent/guardian.
- Other students will be removed from the classroom and taken to an alternate location on campus (e.g. go on a walk outside, move to a different classroom, etc.) so that the classroom can be disinfected.

Fall 2020 Guidance - Secondary

Student & Staff Safety Protocols for Screening & Isolation (page 2)

- District communication will be provided to the parents of students who came in contact with a COVID-19 positive student or staff member.
- Staff members displaying COVID-19 symptoms will follow district protocols including isolation from students and other staff members.

Individuals Confirmed with COVID-19

Any individuals with a lab-confirmed COVID-19 positive test may return to school or work when the following criteria are met:

- At least one day (24 hours) has passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications); and
- The individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and
- At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.

Individuals Considered At-Risk of Exposure

An individual who meets the definition of close contact and at-risk exposure can return to school or work after the 14-day quarantine period expires with no signs of illness.

Individuals Suspected with COVID-19

If an individual who has symptoms that could be COVID-19 is not evaluated by a medical professional or tested for COVID-19, the individual is assumed to have COVID-19, and may not return to school or work until they have completed the same three-step set of criteria listed above.

If the individual has symptoms that could be COVID-19 and wants to return to school or work before completing the stay at home period, the individual must:

- Obtain a medical professional's note clearing (must include date of return to school) the individual for return based on an alternative diagnosis; or
- Obtain an acute infection test (at a physician's office, approved testing location, or other site) that comes back negative for COVID-19.



Lamar CISD Parents,

Through an extended waiver from the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), Lamar CISD will provide free meals to all students from Sept. 21 through Dec. 31, 2020.

On-Campus Students

Lamar CISD students attending on-campus instruction will receive breakfast and lunch at no cost beginning Sept. 21, 2020. Free meals for all students will continue through Dec. 31, or pending available funds through USDA.

Once this waiver expires, the District will switch back to the School Lunch and Breakfast Program. Free and reduced meal applications must still be submitted for the 2020-2021 school year to determine benefits after the waiver ends. Visit www.schoolcafe.com to apply online.

Virtual Students

Free curbside meals are available to students participating in virtual learning, as well as children 18 and under who are not enrolled in Lamar CISD. Child Nutrition will be providing contactless curbside pickup on Mondays only.

Meals will be placed inside of vehicle trunks, truck beds and/or backseats. Families will receive a multi-day meal kit consisting of five breakfasts and five lunches. Families are required to complete an online form every Wednesday by 8 p.m. prior to meal pickup. Meals will not be provided if the form is not submitted.

Parents must provide documentation if you haven't previously received a car placard. The following are acceptable forms of ID:

- Current student ID issued by the District;
- A schedule, or any correspondence from the school with the student ID number on it.
- If the child is not enrolled in Lamar CISD and is not present during meal pick up, the parent must present a birth certificate for each child they're picking up for.

Parents may add funds to their student's meal account for a la carte purchases and in preparation for when the USDA waiver ends. Parents can use the online payment method through www.schoolcafe.com.
