Log into Canvas, then:


- 1. Click

Add Contact Method

Find the Ways to Contact section on the right side of the screen.

Register Communication

- 1. Enter your 10-digit cell phone number.
- Select your cell phone carrier. The SMS Email field will auto-populate your SMS email address.
- 3. Click the Register SMS button.



Confirm SMS Number

Check your cell phone for a confirmation code from Canvas.

- 1. Enter the **code** into the text field or
- 2. click re-send to get the confirmation again.
- 3. Click the **Confirm** button.

- 1. Go back to Account
- 2. Select Notifications



Notification Preferences

Each notification is set to a default preference. To change a notification for a contact method, locate the notification and click the icon for your preferred delivery type.

Each notification preference will automatically apply to all your courses. They cannot be set individually. SMS notification preferences do not support daily or weekly summary options.
