2. Review of CIP to indicate what we accomplished to date

- All goals and strategies on the CIP were reviewed regarding progress.
- a. Copy of report card
 - Handout Provided
 - Students performed well on achievement. We are working on student progress of all students.
 - Distinctions were discussed. Attendance was discussed on how it plays into distinctions.
 - We discussed the Attendance Review Committee starting the perfect attendance plan.
- b. Presentation of Math plans
