Classrooms are to be peanut free. A child with a serious peanut allergy can suffer a reaction merely by touching or smelling a peanut-containing food. Therefore, we are asking parents to adhere to the following:

- Please do not send any peanuts, peanut butter or foods containing peanuts or peanut butter to be eaten as snacks in the classroom.
- We will not be doing any class projects that involve peanuts or peanut butter. Please do not send any projects containing peanuts/peanut butter.
- Any food sent in to share with students should be limited to one item per classmate and should be
  a store purchased single serve item (i.e. cookie, cupcake, etc.) with an ingredient list which is
  peanut free. Single serve items also allow for the treat to be served, eaten and cleaned up within a
  reasonable amount of time.

The above does not apply to lunches, only to classroom snacks. We are trying to ensure the safety of all our children. Thank you in advance for your cooperation. We know that in working together we strive to create a safe environment for all students.
