2. Purpose of the Committee - The Campus Improvement Council is charged with collaborating in the decision-making process for optimal student success.

4. Advisory Discussion Items
  - Campus Improvement Plan
    - Goal 1 - social emotional - less than 10% of students will report being bullied
    - Goal 2 - 5<sup>th</sup> grade STAAR Science meets will increase by 5%
    - Goal 3 - Kindergarden students will be 90% on grade for reading, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade will be 95% on level for reading
    - Goal 4 - % of 3<sup>rd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> grades students that score masters on Reading STAAR will increase by 5% (2024 - 3<sup>rd</sup> -56%, 4<sup>th</sup> - 59%, 5<sup>th</sup> - 61%)
    - Goal 5 - % of 3<sup>rd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> grades students that score masters on Math STAAR will increase by 5% (2024 - 3<sup>rd</sup> -42%, 4<sup>th</sup> - 54%, 5<sup>th</sup> - 42%)

    - Ideas for innovative were brainstormed and recorded on a list:

- Junior Achievement, Career Fair/Hobbies, Coding and Robotics, Brazos Bend, Animal Control, Wildlife center of Texas, Ag. Extension office, Museum of Natural Science, Kinder – social emotional skills, Brazos Valley saving/spending, setting up a store to teach budgeting and economics, yoga, nutrition, Legos, lifeguard, fire fighter, police, coach with lessons on never giving up and mind wellness, performing arts programs (dance, instrumentals, museum etiquette, sales skills and speaking skills, etiquette for eating/watching a movie, online safety and online footprint, author visits,
