Advanced Placement, CTE & SAT Final Exam Options**

- **College Board Advanced Placement Final Exam Option**

- A. AP Exam Registration via Total Registration: February 1 – February 28, 2018
- B. AP Late Exam Registration via Total Registration: March 5-7, 2018

Cost of AP test for student receiving “Free & Reduced Federal Lunch Program”	\$
Exam Fee	\$94
Less School rebate	\$9
College Board reduction	\$32
Texas Fee Reduction	\$24
Cost per “Free & Reduced Student”	\$29

- C. AP registered student will attend AP exam tutorials & sit for practice AP exam
- D. AP registered student may elect to accept practice exam grade for final exam grade or request an EX in lieu of the practice final exam grade.
- E. AP registered student must successfully attend and complete the scheduled AP exam in May 2018.

- **SAT (11th grade): March 7, 2018 Final Exam Option**

- A. SAT registered 11th grade student must successfully attend and complete the scheduled SAT exam on Wednesday, March 7, 2018.
- B. SAT registered 11th grade student must successfully earn a score of 480 Evidence Based Reading & Writing (EBRW)
- C. SAT registered 11th grade student must successfully earn a score of 530 on Math portion
- D. SAT registered 11th grade student who successfully scores a 480 (EBRW) and/or a 530 on the Math portion may elect to exempt their spring 2018 ELA final exam and/or spring 2018 math final exam. Student has demonstrated CCMR readiness.

- **Spring 2018 CTE Course Certification Final Exam Option**

- A. CTE enrolled student will register for the associated course certification
- B. CTE enrolled student must successfully attend and complete the scheduled CTE assessment during the spring 2018 semester.
- C. CTE enrolled student may elect to accept practice CTE certification assessment grade for final exam grade or request an EX in lieu of the practice certification assessment grade.
- D. CTE certification assessment fees paid via CTE district office

- **EOC 2018 Score Final Exam Option**

- A. If a student scores “Masters” on their EOC test this spring, they may exempt the semester final exam for the content class where they earned a “Masters” in Math, Science, English or Social Studies.
- B. EOC final exam option applies to first time EOC takers and retesters.
