

April 10th: 5th grade Reading


It is important that your child be in attendance and on time on testing days. Please arrange any doctor's appointments for after school and make sure your child brings a sack lunch or lunch money with them to school. We ask that parents not bring in fast food items or lunches on this day for any grade level due to schedule changes and test security. Students may bring a snack and water bottle on testing days. Please make sure the snack does not include anything in liquid form or greasy/cheesy.

Parents and visitors are not allowed on campus on the dates listed above. Therefore, visitors are not allowed to eat lunch with students at any grade level, volunteer, or visit the classrooms.

We appreciate your assistance in helping us create a positive testing environment for all of the students.



Per the Texas Education Agency (TEA), the use of cell phones and other personal electronic devices including smartwatches, laptops, tablet computers, portable listening or recording devices, cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the internet and any other electronic device during testing is not permitted during STAAR testing. Electronic devices must be powered off and turned in to the Test Administrator to hold until ALL students have completed the STAAR test. Unauthorized possession of any electronic device(s) during STAAR testing may result in invalidation of the student's STAAR test and disciplinary action taken by campus administration."
