Attendance

- ▶ Your child's daily attendance is crucial to his/her academic growth. If your child must miss due to illness, please note that children must be free of fever (less than 100.0 degrees) for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications (such as Tylenol or Advil / Motrin) before returning to school. Children must be free of diarrhea for 24 hours before returning to school and need to be eating and drinking without any problem. If a child vomits two or more times within 24 hours, they will need to stay home for at least 24 hours to ensure they are not contagious.

- ▶ Our school day begins at 7:45 am. Tardiness disturbs classroom routines and hinders your child's progress

Pre-Kindergarten has implemented an updated full-day curriculum that integrates the Texas State Pre-K Guidelines. Teachers have implemented the balanced literacy approach which includes interactive read alouds, shared reading and writing to develop oral and emergent literacy skills. Teachers work with students in small groups to address skills such as phonological awareness, vocabulary and comprehension.

Students use concrete objects such as manipulatives to problem solve during math instruction & centers. Our staff is trained in Capturing Kids Hearts, Fred Jones, and Conscious Discipline to assist students with their social emotional growth. Our students learn to explore through scientific investigations. These explorations continue as children make observations and predictions, problem-solve, compare, and as they ask questions.

Student academic progress will be monitored using mCircle comprehensive assessment that will provide teachers and campus administrator with information on what children are learning and rates of improvement across the preschool year. Teachers will use this information to monitor and provide interventions to students who are not demonstrating adequate progress. Teachers report that they can adapt their curricular activities and instructional approaches to be more responsive to the children’s needs through this assessment.



Eligibility for Pre-Kindergarten:

- ▶ Be 4 years old on or before September 1st
- ▶ Be unable to speak/comprehend English or
- ▶ Qualify for free/reduced lunches or
- ▶ Be homeless or,
- ▶ Is or has ever been in conservatorship of the Dept. of Family and Protective Services or,
- ▶ Is the dependent child of an active U.S. Armed Forces member, or the dependent of a U.S. Armed Forces member that has been injured or killed while on active duty

Registration Process

- ▶ Parents/Guardians may register online at home or are welcome to come to Seguin to utilize our computers.
- ▶ Please bring the following documents for registration:
 - Certified Birth Certificate
 - Original Social Security card for the child
 - Proof of address such as a utility bill, voter registration card, or lease agreement
 - Record of shots
 - Driver’s License or ID
