### Lamar CISD Bond Propositions A and D Approved

On Nov. 3, the Lamar CISD community passed the largest bond referendum in the District's history, approving Propositions A and D at \$666,810,864.

Once sold, these bond funds will be used to build a new high school, junior high and three elementary schools, purchase land and buses, renovate more than 30 campuses and provide much needed support for our students and staff through technology devices.

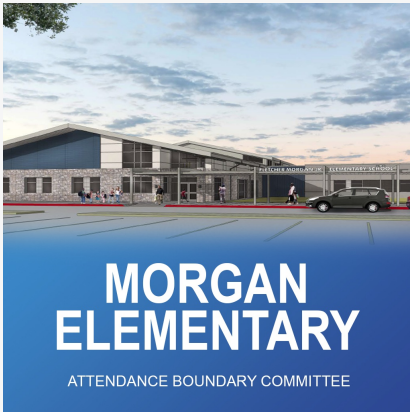
### November Randle Report

director of Career and Technical Education.



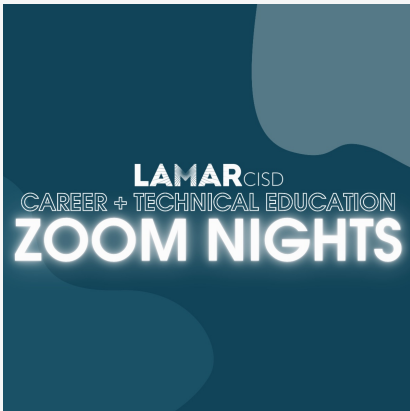
