## Lamar CISD to Save Nearly \$40 Million through Bond Refinancing

The District recently refinanced a portion of the outstanding bonds from 2012 and 2016, which will produce an estimated cash savings of \$39.980 million over the life of the bonds. With the help of the District's financial advisory firm, Post Oak Municipal Advisors, the pricing took place in early October and the overall interest rate on these bonds decreased from an average of 4.57 percent to roughly 2.25 percent.


#### **VIDEOS: Nivens' News**
