Parent information

Regarding Teacher Qualifications

Parents of students attending any school receiving Title I, Part A, funds may request and the district will provide (in a timely manner and in an understandable and uniform format and, to the extent practicable, provided in a language that the parents can understand) information regarding the professional qualifications of the student's classroom teachers, including the following:

- Whether the teacher has met State qualifications and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived
- What the baccalaureate degree major of the teacher is and whether any other graduate certification or degree is held by the teacher, and what field of discipline for the certification or degree
- Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals, and if so, their qualifications{P.L. 107-110, Section 1111(h)(6)}
