Process to Develop Consensus

- Critical aligns with master plan principles; if project is not approved, there will be a negative impact on students and district as a whole. (crucial, major, imperative)
- High project is needed to achieve district's mission and to serve students. (important, needed, significant)
- Desired project will be advantageous for district and students. (beneficial, helpful, useful)
