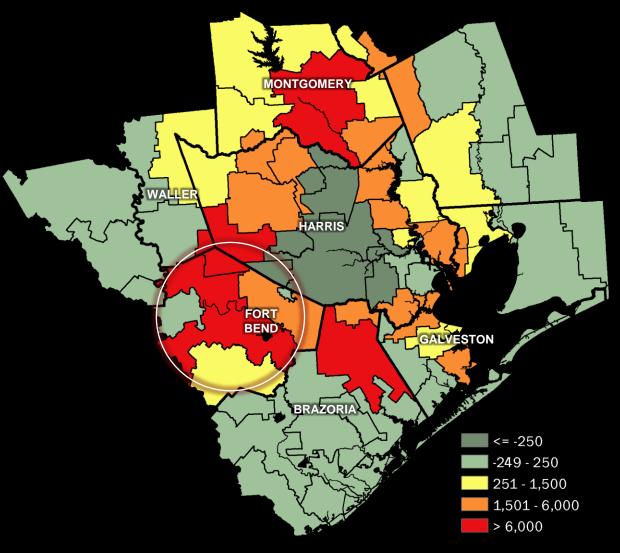

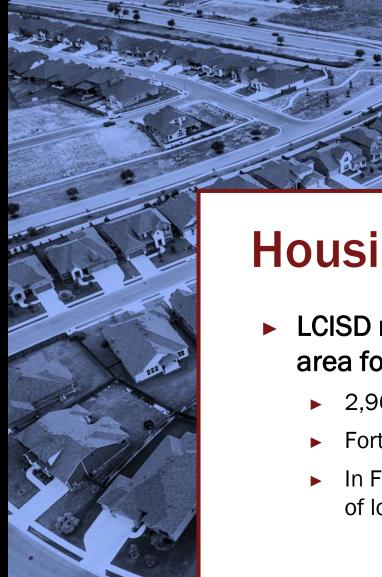

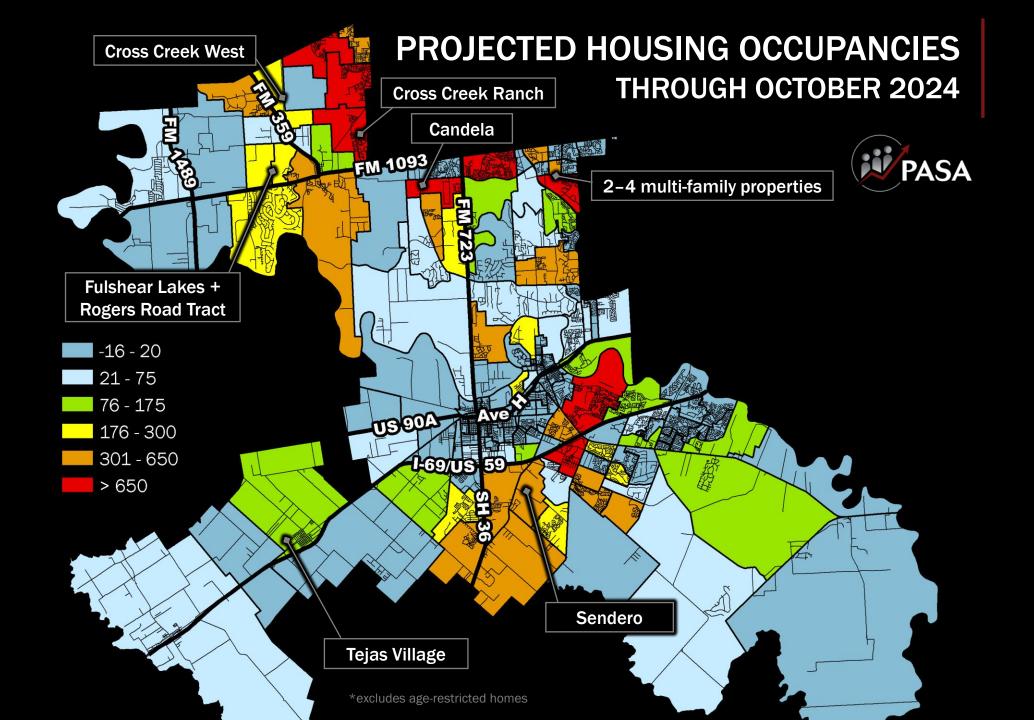

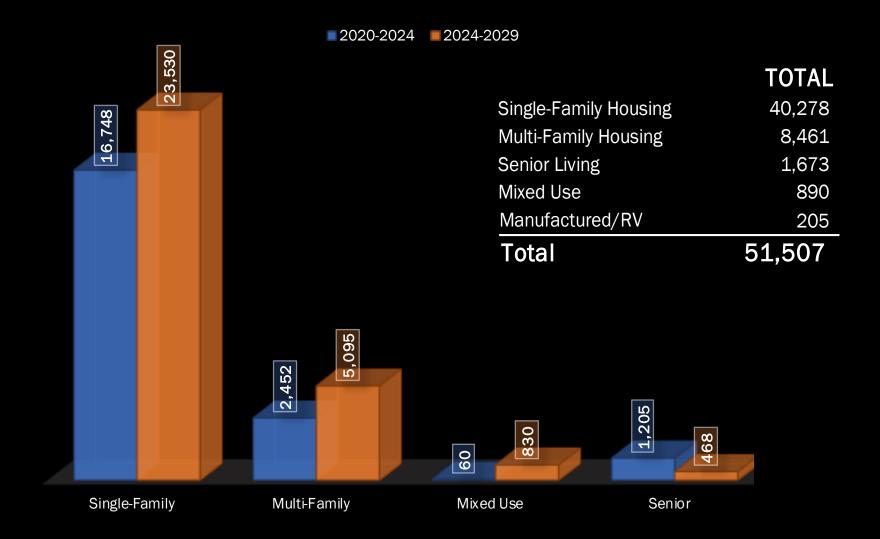
Housing Trends
