Defined by Board Policy and Texas Education Code 11.251

A superintendent shall regularly consult the district-level committee in the planning, operation, supervision and evaluation of the district educational program. *BQA(Legal)*

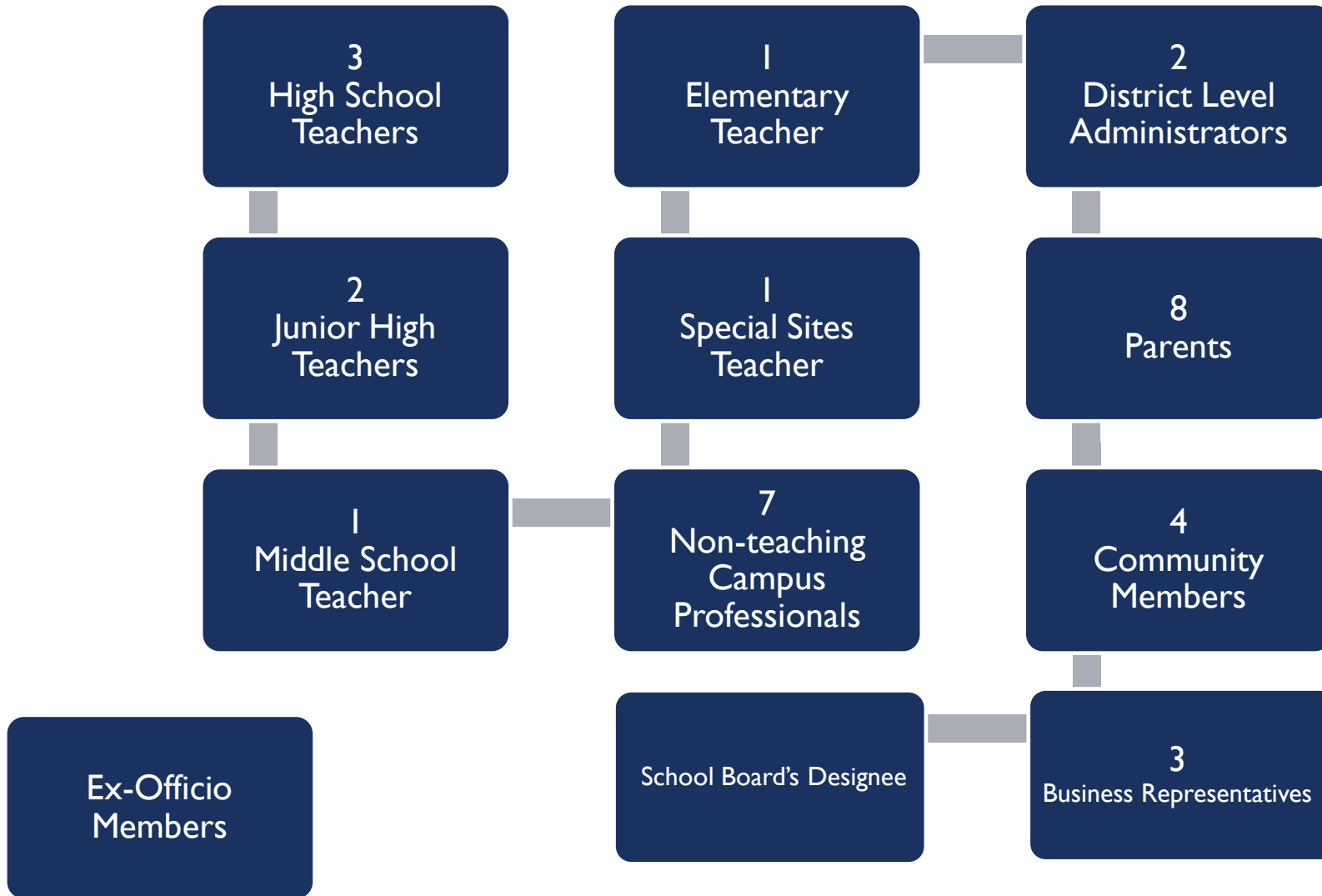
## Composition of Council

# DSIC LEADERSHIP ROLES

## Chairperson of DSIC

- Elected yearly from membership
- Meets with District DSIC coordinator to prepare agenda prior to meeting
- Preside over meetings

## Secretary of DSIC

- Elected yearly from membership
- Preside in absence of chairperson
- Maintains detailed minutes to be shared out with Council members
